Enhanced Power BI Tool with Full 2025 Port State Control Statistics

The Mediterranean Memorandum of Understanding on Port State Control (Med MoU) is pleased to announce the successful update of its Microsoft Power BI data visualization tool, now incorporating complete 2025 inspection statistics. The tool, provided by the European Maritime Safety Agency (EMSA) under the SAFEMED V project, is publicly available for all industry stakeholders.

Following the formal endorsement at the 27th Med MoU Committee Session and the completion of the technical update phase in February 2026, EMSA has now integrated the final 2025 data into the live dashboard. This enhancement ensures that all dynamic statistics, performance calculations, and individual ship data reflect the most recent reporting period.
